




Type A – Single unit with one bathroom

STUDENT HOUSING INFORMATION

The Myrtle and Earl Walker Residence Hall is the first on-campus dormitory in Ranken's history. Walker Hall features excellent amenities along with great room options.

Fall and Spring Room Options and Costs

Room costs are based on a contract covering the fall and spring semesters.

- A. Single unit with 1 bathroom, (\$2,900 per semester per person)
- B. Single unit with shared bathroom, (\$2,600 per semester per person)
- C. Double unit with 1 bathroom, (\$1,850 per semester per person)
- D. 2-bedroom apartment with 1 bathroom, closet in each bedroom, living room, several are equipped with refrigerator, microwave and stove. <u>There is no quarantee placement in units with kitchens</u>. (\$2,575 per semester per person)
- E. 4-bedroom apartment with 2 bathrooms, living room, and kitchen equipped with refrigerator, microwave and stove, (\$2,975 per semester per person)

Meal Plan

Meal Plan costs for fall and spring semester. Meal plans are mandatory for all residents. Meal plans are based on a declining balance.

- \$750 per semester plan
- \$900 per semester plan
- \$1,100 per semester plan

Laundry Plan

The cost for the laundry plan is \$75 during the school year and \$30 for the summer semester which provides unlimited access to the laundry room. The cost is deducted from your meal plan.

Summer Housing Costs:

St. Louis Students: \$1,200 (Double Units Available Only), \$300 Meal Plan and the optional \$30 Laundry Plan. Insurance will be charged if necessary.

Wentzville and Automotive Internship Students: \$750(Double Units Available Only), \$150 Meal Plan and the optional \$30 Laundry Plan. Insurance will be charged if necessary.

Submit your housing security deposit of \$150.00 to the Business Office. Payments can be made over the phone at 314-286-4869 or via mail to 4431 Finney Ave, St. Louis, MO 63113. Make all payments to Ranken Technical College. Note "Housing Deposit" in the memo section of the check.
Read and completed required forms in the Move-in Packet. The packet is located on the Residential Life page of www.ranken.edu and will be mailed to your Ranken email account. Submit all required immunizations and medical history forms to Residential Life. These items can be faxed to 314-286-3303, emailed to reslife@ranken.edu or mailed to 4431 Finney Ave., St. Louis, MO 63113.
Complete all financial obligations for tuition and housing costs with Financial Aid and the Business Office. <i>Please remember, students will not receive a housing assignment if the above items are not completed.</i>
