

## Lanny Lamont Endowed Scholarship Manufacturing Division

Lanny Lamont was born in St. Louis, Missouri. Mr. Lamont attended Bradley University and majored in both business and engineering, graduating in 1960. In 1963, Mr. Lamont founded Davlan Engineering, Inc. and remains its president. Lanny Lamont is a member of the Ranken Technical College Board of Trustees.

During his career Mr. Lamont became a business associate and friend of Earl Walker. Before his passing Mr. Walker, a 1940 graduate of the College, was a member of the Ranken Technical College Board of Trustees. Earl and Lanny worked together to establish Carr Lane Manufacturing, Quality Screw Machine Products and Carr Lane Castings. These businesses employ hundreds, including many Ranken graduates, and have been long-time supporters of Ranken Technical College.

Earl's daughter, Mary Walker, has established the "Lanny Lamont Endowed Scholarship" in honor of her father's friend to recognize Mr. Lamont's generous support of the St. Louis region, his efforts to grow manufacturing locally, and for his many years of business advice and loyal friendship to her father.

The amount of the award varies and is determined annually by the Scholarship Coordinator. This scholarship can be applied to all educational expenses, including tuition, books, tools and housing.

Selection will be based on the following criteria:

- Must be enrolled full-time
- Must be enrolled in a program within the Manufacturing Division
  - Advanced Manufacturing Technology
  - Precision Machining Technology
  - Industrial Technology
  - Fabrication and Welding Technology
  - A student from another department may be selected if a qualified applicant is not chosen from one of the programs above.
- Must have successfully completed at least one semester in the Ranken Technical College curriculum
- Must have a "Meets" or "Exceeds" expectations on work ethic grade
- Complete scholarship application before the applicable deadline
