**Student will submit Certificate of Eligibility (COE) prior to start of first term to initiate benefits review.**

**Registration Fee: \$95**

**Tuition (2022-2023) per semester:**

- Full-time Day = \$7,860 (12-24 hours of technical and general education classes)
- Part-time Evening = \$3,930 (6 hours of technical education)
- General Education only = \$537 per 3 credit hour class
- BSAM Education only = \$1,113 per 3 credit hour class

**Fees (2022-2023) per semester:**

- Full-time Day = \$620 Student Fee
- Part-time Evening = \$300 Student Fee
- General Education only = \$300 Student Fee
- Diesel (Perryville) = \$2,045
- Automotive (Wentzville) = \$1,295
- Lap Top Fee – Architecture (\$500), Electrical Systems Design (\$360) & Building Systems Design (Wentzville \$380)
- Testing Fee – Automotive \$100 (All Day programs – St. Louis & Wentzville), Professional Collision Repair \$153 (All Day & Evening programs), Information Technology \$200 (Day programs), Information Technology \$130 (Evening programs), Advanced Precision Machining \$120 (Day programs), Precision Machining \$50 (Evening programs), Fabrication & Welding \$180 (Day program), Fabrication & Welding \$120 (Evening), Industrial Engineering Technology \$50

**Estimated Books/Tools per semester:**

- Books = \$131-\$400 (depending on program)
- Tools = \$400-\$5,000 (for the initial first semester tool kit depending on program)

**\*Tool costs vary greatly by program. Most programs require an initial tool kit (estimated cost above); however, may require additional tools in subsequent semesters.**

**Estimated Cost of Living (Room/Board, Transportation & Personal Expenses) per semester:**

- Room/Board = \$6,074
- Transportation = \$1,260
- Personal/Misc. = \$4,126

**\*The above Cost of Living amounts are based on figures provided by The College Board – Moderate (Prevailing) Budgets. These are also Indirect Costs and are not charged to your student billing but are used to calculate the Cost of Attendance.**

**Financial Aid:**

- Pell Grant awards vary from \$711 - \$6,895 per academic year based on your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as determined by the FAFSA & enrollment status.
- SEOG awards of \$500 may be available to students with a zero EFC (who are full-time) until the funds are exhausted.
- Student loans are available to students to assist with educational expenses. Students should borrow responsibly and only what is needed. Students may borrow (if eligible), between \$5,500 to \$10,500 per year, depending on grade level in school and dependency status. Student loans plus interest must be repaid. Use My Federal Student Aid account (<https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/sign-in/landing>) to find out how much you owe in federal loans.

**Registration:**

- Student is pre-registered in all required courses required for graduation upon admission to the college. Subsequent registration changes must be initiated in the Registrar’s Office or Student Success Department.
- **Courses that CANNOT be certified:** Remedial courses and Continuing Education courses.
