- The scholarship will be split evenly over the academic year
- The student receiving the scholarship <u>must maintain a career GPA of 2.5 or higher</u> to continue receiving the scholarship
- The student must also achieve a work ethic grade of MEE (Meets Expectations) or higher to continue receiving the scholarship
