SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENT/RESTRICTIONS:

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS/RESTRICTIONS:

- Applicants must be recently graduated from the Center for Academic & Social Advancement program at Normandy High School and attending Ranken Technical College for their first year.
- Applicants must have a cumulative high school GPA of **2.5** or higher
- The scholarship is for full-time (*12 hours minimum*) day school students
- The scholarship will be split evenly over the academic year

To continue receiving the *CASA Scholarship for Normandy High School* the recipient must:

- The student receiving the scholarship must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher to continue receiving the scholarship each semester
- The student must also achieve a work ethic grade of **MEE** (*Meets Expectations*) or higher to continue receiving the scholarship

Disclosure of Scholarship Recipient Information and Donor Acknowledgment

As a condition of accepting a scholarship from Ranken Technical College, please be aware of the following:

1. Disclosure of Information to Donors

This means such information may be released unless you have formally requested to restrict its disclosure. If you do not wish for your information to be shared as described above, you must notify the Financial Aid Office in writing within two weeks of your enrollment or scholarship acceptance.
